Many of you have been praying for a young man named Pey, and I'm thrilled to tell you that he was baptized last Sunday after sharing a tremendous testimony of salvation. The story of grace in his life is unbelievable - truly like it jumped right off the script of a movie.

At thirteen, Pey was conscripted into a tribal militia in his birth country. With little training, he was armed and sent into an active border conflict. Desperate to get out of the terrible situation, he fled with a friend. They were caught, quickly tried, and sentenced to execution the following day. Another child soldier managed to slip something in their guard's drink that night and free them. They escaped this time, but knew that they could not return to their home villages, and decided to flee into Thailand.

The story goes on with incredible details of tricking a "border crossing guide" into getting them over the border when they had nothing to pay him, spending time in a Thai jail, and a Christian businesswoman hearing his story and bailing him out. Now he has been living in Thailand for over a decade.

Our paths crossed in a pretty incredible way. He told me he was looking for

a place to learn about God, and found our church on google. He showed his phone to a coworker, because he thought she had said something about being a Christian. The coworker was a faithful member of our church, baptized early last year, and she showed him how to get here the next Sunday. Pretty great, right? Please pray that God will continue to move powerfully in his life!
